The Charles L. Becton Scholarship is to motivate and reward young men ages, 12-25 who demonstrate leadership in their, schools, homes, and communities. Leadership does not just happen. Leaders personally invest and risk much. They must take on struggles that many would avoid and persevere to reach successful outcomes. These qualities should receive special attention in the selection of the award winner. Charles L. Becton possesses all of these qualities and more.

The Charles L. Becton Scholarship is (3) \$1,000. The minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- a. Open to men ages, 12-25
- b. GPA of 3.0 or higher (if applicable)
- c. Demonstrated interest in addressing the lack of leadership in society today.
- d. Submission of a personal statement of 1,000 words highlighting candidate's interest in leadership; relevant experience and interests; and how this award will contribute to the candidate's ability to make a meaningful contribution in their community.
- e. Previous years Scholarship winner is not eligible.

The Scholarship Committee will be looking for other qualifications that will be found in your essay, and letters of recommendation.

The scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific goals, academic record and leadership-related activities or job skills. Minority candidates are encouraged to apply.
